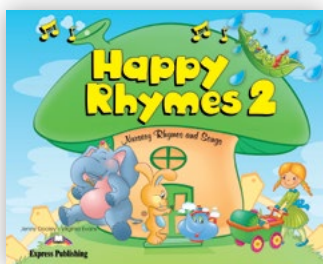
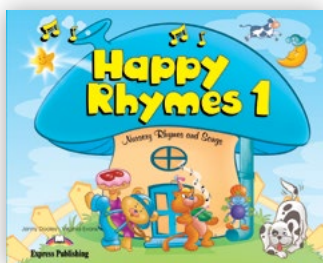
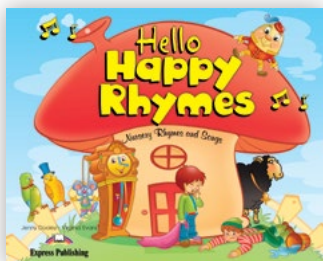


Happy Rhymes

Use

We use the past simple for:

- an action which was completed at a stated or implied time in the past. They bought a new house last week. (When? Last week.)
- actions that happened immediately one after the other in the past. She woke up, had his breakfast and got ready for work.
- past habits. In this case we use adverbs of frequency (always, often, usually, etc.). I often went camping when I was young.
- people who are no longer alive. Charlie Dickens wrote many children's books. (Charles Dickens is dead.)

Time words used with the past simple: e.g. yesterday, last month/week, in 1996, etc.

We use the past continuous for:

- an action which was in progress at a stated time in the past. We did not know when the action started or finished, at 2 o'clock this afternoon, they were having lunch at an outdoor cafe. (We do not know when they started or when they finished.)
- two or more actions which were happening at the same time in the past. She was drinking coffee while her husband was reading the newspaper.
- a past action which was in progress when another action interrupted it. He was walking to work when he met a friend in the street. Two women – action in progress, met – action which interrupted the action in progress.
- to give the background information in a story. The wind was blowing and the sun was shining. It was a perfect day for windsurfing.

Time words used with the past continuous: while, when, as, all day/night/morning, all day/yesterday, etc.

Happiness Explained

The Chemicals of Happiness

1 The word **neuro-** means "related to the nervous system," which means the network of nerve cells and fibers that send messages around the body. A neurochemical is a molecule that affects the nervous system.

2 There are hundreds of neurochemicals in the human body, and several of those are related to happiness. We will take a closer look at four important ones in this chapter. All of these neurochemicals, when released into your bloodstream, cause feelings of happiness.

3 Think about the last time you set a goal and achieved it. You probably felt proud and happy. You felt the effects of **dopamine**, sometimes called the "reward molecule." Some scientists believe that too much dopamine can lead to addiction (think, for example, of someone who has difficulty quitting a video game because he keeps winning points).

4 **Oxytocin**, the "bonding molecule," is activated by being with other people. A mother holding her child, students working together, or friends playing basketball can all experience the effects of oxytocin.

5 Runners and other athletes who train hard experience the happiness that comes from **endorphin**, the "pain-killing molecule." Athletes sometimes talk about pushing through the pain of physical effort to a state where they feel calm and happy.

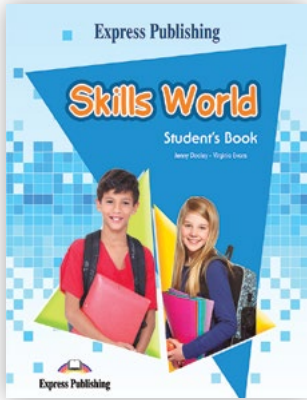
6 Be careful with **adrenaline**, the "risk molecule." Too much risk can be dangerous. But a little risk makes you feel excited, in a pleasant way, especially if you know you are safe. That's why skiers, mountaineers, and skydivers often feel happy practicing their sport.

7 Understanding the purpose of them and other neurochemicals and what increases their presence is an important step in understanding what makes people happy – and also how to increase our own happiness.
